This fantastic photo records one of the most historic moments in the modern era of the IGL Retriever Championship. *FTCh Breeze of Drakeshead has just won his third and final victory at the 1987 Championship* at her Majesty the Queen's Sandringham Estate in Norfolk. *He is the only dog to win three successive Championships, a feat never accomplished before nor repeated since.*

Perhaps even more remarkable, Breeze won both the 1986 and 1987 competitions with a heavily bandaged forepaw (as seen in the photo).

With this final victory six-year old Breeze won the Glen Kidston Challenge Cup outright before being retired. In a gesture of great generosity, John Halstead re-presented the cup to the IGL in perpetuity.
